- Have you ever attended a function in the Bradford Morse House at Ridge Hill?
- Do you know the history of this town property?

Once the Bradford Estate, the town originally purchased 222 acres in 1972 and put it under the oversight of the Conservation Commission. Through additional acquisitions, the reservation now includes 360 acres of uplands, trails and access to the Charles River.

Until recently, the Bradford Morse house was open for public use. The Selectmen have been responsible for the house and the surrounding 3 acres since the Massachusetts legislature allowed that parcel to be separated from the rest of the reservation land for building a senior center. What will happen to this site now that the senior center will be built elsewhere in Needham?

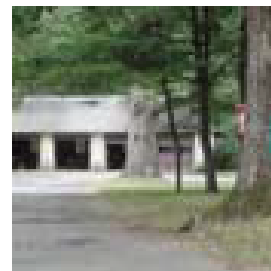
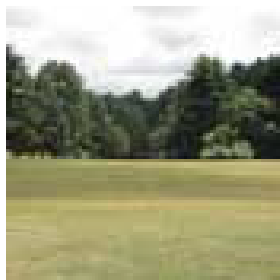
